Drawn into Art! A Visual Exploration of Media & Techniques

Robert Bean, Associate Professor of Fine Arts, Department of Education, Alabama A&M University, will lead us through an overview of drawing media, subject matter, and techniques. Explore line, shape, form, value, perspective, and composition through a variety of techniques. Teachers will learn ways to enhance their visual arts classroom curricula. *Drawn into Art! A Visual Exploration of Media & Techniques* workshop will assist teachers in aiding students to develop critical thinking skills and in the understanding of the creative process. Through a presentation of drawing media artwork, participants will have the opportunity to develop their own drawing skills as well as work in a variety of media (pen & ink, graphite and charcoal). Discover ways to solve drawing problems. Work with rhythm and movement to translate what you see onto paper. The workshop is presented in conjunction with the *Visual Arts Achievement Program* (March 11-March 18), *Congressional Art Competition*, and *Youth Art Month* (March 11-April 29) exhibitions.

Robert Bean's Biography: B.F.A. from Mississippi State University and M.F. A. from Louisiana State University, Drawing and Painting. Mr. Bean taught classes in figure painting and drawing at Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge, LA. He taught other classes in drawing, painting, and two-dimensional design. His works have been shown in group and solo exhibitions. He is currently teaching portrait, landscape, and still life painting and drawing classes and workshops at the Huntsville Museum of Art's Museum Academy. He has a studio at Lowe Mill Arts & Entertainment Center.

Workshop will be held on **Friday, April 6, 2012 from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** in the Huntsville Museum of Art's Museum Academy classrooms. *There is no fee for this workshop.* Space is limited. **Register Early!** A workshop confirmation letter will be sent to you via email upon receipt of your registration.
